Updated from Principal and VP

- Trivia nights have been really fun and successful

- Spirit week March 15-19 (previously March Break)
- Report cards posted Thurs Feb 18th
- Teacher wellness is very important and the past 6 months have been incredibly difficult and stressful. January online learning had many challenges for staff and so the focus for Feb and March is to ensure that all staff are well cared for. Student anxiety is also increasing since coming back to school. Staff are being mindful of student workload, checking with students and families regularly, to ensure that students and families are supported.
- Planning for next year has begun Kindergarten registration numbers were submitted to the board last Friday, Grade 1-8 registration numbers submitted next Friday. Staff assignments are usually completed in March. Expecting consistent numbers for Woodroffe next year (650 in a normal year, 500 during COVID)
- OCDSB will likely offer the option to continue with online learning in 2021-22
- Grade 7 Info Night happened for new families (including returning Severn families) that will be joining Woodroffe next year for Grade 7. Slide deck will be posted on the Woodroffe website.
- Grade 8 graduation is almost certainly virtual and can include the Grade 8 OCV students.
- Indoor shoes cannot be stored at school as the custodial staff needs to clean the entire classroom and student bins are full of work and supplies. Council looking into drawstring bags for hanging shoes from hooks.
